INFORMATION TO ALL CUSTOMERS

W21 COVID-restrictions within Austria and JNUS

In Austria a full lock-down until mid of December took place and is still in place for unvaccinated peoples. Additional health requirements are in place for travelers arriving from certain countries at the borders, because of the high amount of infections with the Omicron-variant in several countries since a few weeks entry into Austria from these countries is limited to fully vaccinated people with a negative test only.

As the pandemic situation remains very volatile and the new "Omicron" variant is creating even more uncertainty, immigration rules are changing constantly.

Therefore, Schedule Coordination Austria will accept:

- The extension of the application of JNUS until 30th January 2022;
- A "recovery period" from January 31 to February 13, 2022 inclusive.

We would like to draw the attention to all carriers that they are still requested to cancel all their allocated slots as soon as they decide not to operate.

We will closely monitor the developments and plan to re-evaluate the situation on 19th January 2022. SCA reserves the right to change these rules again on short notice after information to all customers.

These measures will be valid for international flights only, independent of origin or destination, and for Level 3 airports Vienna and Innsbruck (Days 6 and 7 only).
