Information to all Airlines operating to Innsbruck on Saturday or Sunday during winter season

Schedule Coordination Austria GmbH (SCA) is the slot coordinator and schedule facilitator for Innsbruck Airport.

In 2016 the Coordination Committee for Innsbruck Airport voted by a majority in favor of an application of INN Airport to extend the minimum series length from (at this time existing) 10 frequencies to 15 frequencies as of W16/17. This new series length was challenged by one carrier with the Federal Ministry of Transport, Innovation and Technology (BMVIT).

In a written communication, dated July 3rd, 2018, the Federal Ministry of Transport, Innovation and Technology (GZ.BMVIT-58.461/0001-IV/L2/2017) published its decision that the local guideline for airport INN about "minimum 15 weeks for Saturdays and Sundays" is not in line with EU-Regulation 95/93 and therefore overruled in its capacity as supervising authority the voting decision of the Coordination Committee.

Therefore SCA will withdraw this local rule and will with immediate effect apply the minimum length for slot series of 5 weeks, allocated at the same day and the same time as from W18 season.

We would like to alert you once again that all allocated slots for W18 season you do not consider to use in W18/19 should be cancelled and returned to SCA until August 15th, 2018 (Slot Return Deadline) at the latest.

All slots allocated on August 31st, 2018 (Historics Baseline Date) will constitute the Baseline for W18 for the calculation of Historics for W19/INN.

Any return of slots after August 31st, 2018 will be considered as a late handback and circumvention of EU-Regulation 95/93 and the Worldwide Slot Guidelines.
