

## Information for GA/BA

### Subject: New AIP SUP – “Airport Slot ID”

Dear Sir or Madam,

As part of the implementation of Single European Sky and in accordance with EU-Regulation 95/93 (Slot-regulation) and EU-regulation 255/2010 it is planned to process flight plan consistency checks on a European basis.

In preparation for this, an “Airport Slot ID” must be stated by the aircraft operator in field 18 of the ATC flight plan.

As of February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2012, an “Airport Slot ID” will be stated on all confirmations of requested slots in the IATA GCR-message by the airport slot coordinator.

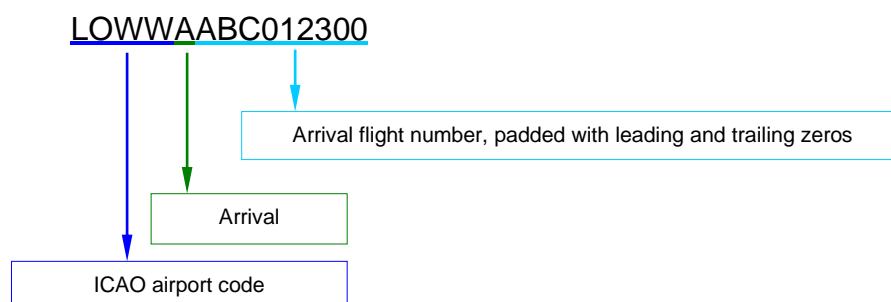

#### “Airport Slot ID” structure:

The “Airport Slot ID” is composed of 14 alphanumeric characters.

- 1-4: ICAO airport code
- 5: “A”...Arrival, “D”...Departure
- 6-14: Flight number given from Airport coordinator, padded with leading and trailing zeros
